

Transparency report for PFL payments to members of the public in the United Kingdom - 2023

This document contains the methodological note and the transparency data for payments made by Pierre Fabre UK (PFL) to members of the public, including patients and journalists, in accordance with the ABPI Code of Practice for the Pharmaceutical Industry (the ABPI Code) between 01 January 2023 and 31st December 2023.

The term **Payment** means financial support provided by PFL to a member of the public who we engage with for services specifically related to healthcare, disease, or medicine.

The term **Member of Public** includes, but is not limited to, patients, carers, health economists, and journalists, who PFL engages with for services specifically related to healthcare, disease, or medicine and live in the United Kingdom.

Services provided by a member of the public can include consultancy, advisory or training roles related to healthcare, disease, or medicine, participating in market research, or speaking engagements. Payments for work to support clinical trials are excluded if they fall within the remit of Research and Development payments as defined in the ABPI code, including consultancy specific to a clinical trial or Data Management Committee service. Such payments are reported on Disclosure UK (abpi.org.uk).

Payments to patient advocates or other individuals who are representatives of Patient Organisations for services provided to PFL are not included in these figures. Instead, these payments are reported as payments to Patient Organisations and can be found in a separate report on [Disclosure of Payments to Patient Organisations \(pierre-fabre.com\)](https://pierre-fabre.com)

This disclosure for members of the public is made on an aggregate basis. It includes the total amount of payments made and the total number of individuals included in the report.
