Confidentiality

The secure system guarantees strict confidentiality of the identity of the reporting person, the persons concerned by the report and any third parties mentioned, as well as the integrity and confidentiality of the information collected at all stages in the handling of the report.

Personal data

The personal data of the persons concerned is stored in accordance with the data protection laws in force and will be processed exclusively by Pierre Fabre Group for the purposes of conducting its investigations and taking any corrective measures.
